The Cambridge ESOL Examinations are recognized by over 13,000 universities and employers around the world. Additionally, through the unique Rainbow Pathways partnership with University of Hawaii's Kapiolani Community College (KCC), students accepted into IIE Hawaii FCE or CAE courses are also conditionally accepted into KCC. Upon successful completion of the IIE courses, students can enter KCC directly and take college credit courses.

IIE Hawaii offers courses in the First Certificate in English (FCE) and the Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) three times a year. The FCE is an upper-intermediate level exam, and the CAE is an advanced level exam. Both certificates are challenging, highly-respected assessments of English abilities, and the exam scores are valid for life.

All students must take a Cambridge placement exam at IIE prior to the course. Students whose scores are insufficient will be advised about other academic options.

CAE 2018: Jan. 8-Mar. 9 (9 weeks; exams to Mar. 17; optional free Cambridge review/support March 12-16). Mar. 19-June 8 (12 weeks; exams to June 13). Sept. 10-Nov. 30 (12 weeks; exams to Dec. 5).
