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IIE Aloha Scholarship Eligibility & Requirements

1. Based on financial need and/or purpose of studying English
2. Priority to students from under-represented countries (less than 3 percent of student body) whose plan is to use English in the future to benefit their local community or world at large (this includes people who may already be residing in Hawaii)
3. Must write a short essay or make a video about yourself along with the application
4. Must provide a letter of recommendation from current or former professor/teacher or an authority who can testify to applicant's character and academic/professional/community experience and/or potential
5. While at IIE, students must volunteer at local charities/non-profits to learn about meaning of aloha
6. After completion of program, students must write about the experience or make a video, and how you will use what you've learned in Hawaii in the future
7. Scholarship covers tuition only. Duration minimum 2 months, maximum 12 months
8. Subsidized accommodation may be available dependent on availability
9. Limit per year: enrollment weeks equal to 10 one year enrollments

Conditions

1. Must be able to obtain F-1 Student visa (if not residing in U.S)
2. Must be at least 18
3. Must be able to cover all additional costs of living in Hawaii during this period
4. Must comply with all student rules including attendance
5. IIE will issue no refunds or transfers of the value of the scholarship or subsidy in the event of cancellation, termination, or visa denial.
